

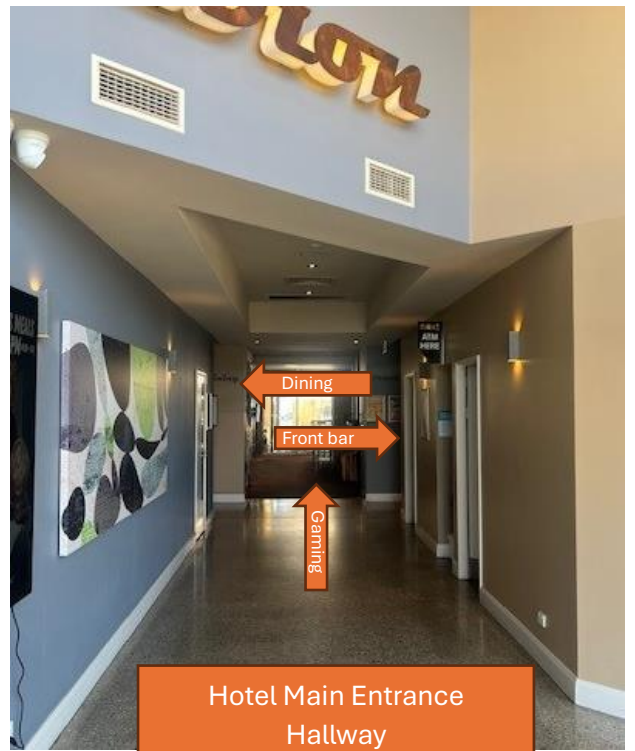
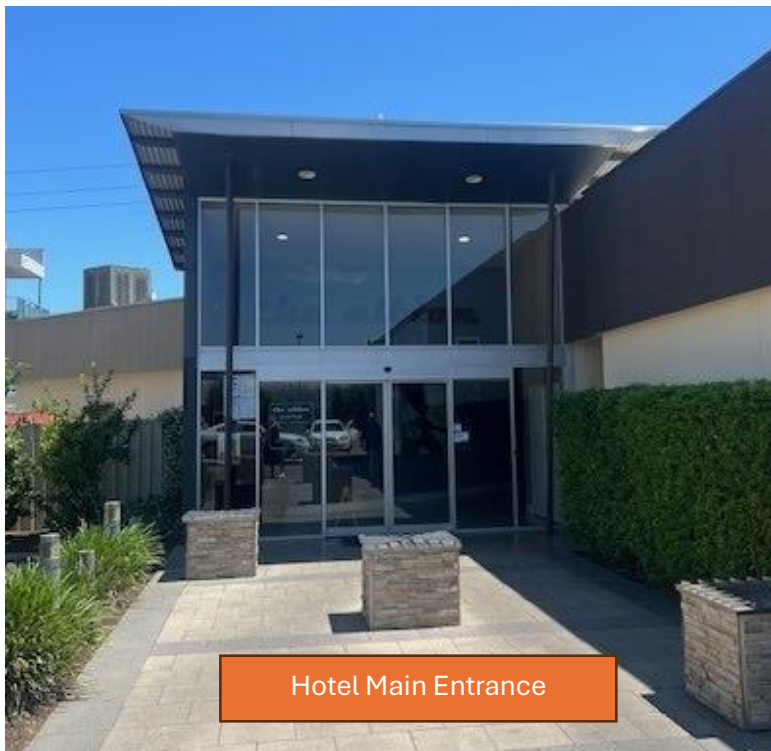
Albion Hotel Accessibility Information

Getting to the Albion hotel

The main entrance is located in the carpark. Entrances to the carpark are accessible from Northcote St and Churchill Road.



When you walk through the main doors, please continue straight until you reach a hallway on your left. This will take you through to the dining room, if you continue straight it will take you to gaming and if you turn right it will lead to the front bar.



Inside the albion hotel – Dining area

Once you enter the bistro, there will be a sign saying, please wait to be seated. A staff member will help you find a table that will suit your needs the best. On your left there will be an open kitchen with some slight noise. There will be some quiet background music playing in all areas of dining but can be turned down if requested. To order food you will have to come to the counter and order – quoting your table number.



There is a variety of different lighting used throughout the dining areas. There is also a significant amount of natural lighting but blinds are available to be closed if you wish.

Lighting used :

- Warm yellow Overhead lights
- Large hanging lights with a yellow hue
- LED light strips over the bar
- Warm lights on the back wall of the garden room

Seating Options

There is a variety of different seating options with a variety of different seats to choose from.

These include-

- Booth seats with soft padded arms chairs
- Padded arm chairs only
- Black, soft chairs
- Wooden hard chairs
- Soft, brown chairs

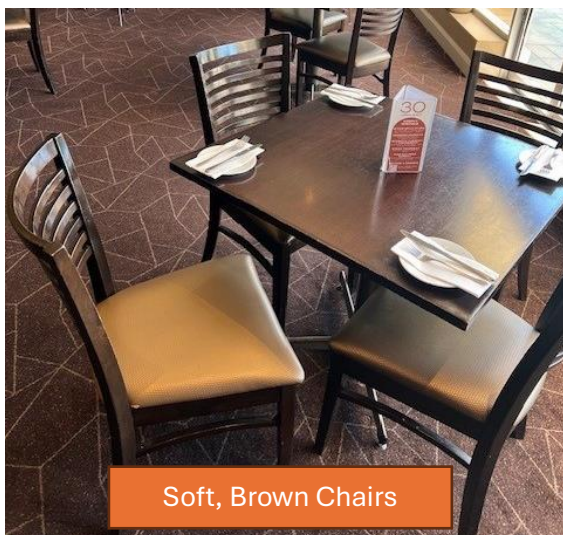
If you have a preference on where and what seating you would like, our staff will do our best to accommodate any request you may have.

Main Bistro –

The main bistro is an open room with large windows on either side of the room, this may let in a lot of natural light but blinds are available to be closed if requested. There is some slight music playing over the speakers. There will be multiple tv screens showing sport, specials and Keno. There is some over head lighting, pendant lights and LED lights on the bar. The main bistro is carpeted.



Garden Room –

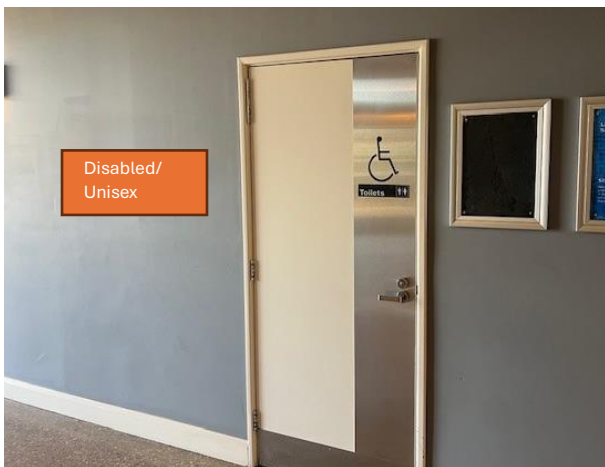
The Garden room is a little more secluded than the main bistro and is situated across from the bar. There is some natural lighting but blinds are available to be closed if requested. There is very slight/no music playing in the garden room and is to be considered a quieter dining area with some TV's playing sport and specials. The garden room is carpeted.

The salad bar is situated at the garden room entrance, there may be some slight noise from other patrons. The salad bar has a yellow heat lamp and white florescent lights. You may hear some slight noise from the kitchen.



Toilets –

There are Male, Female and Disabled toilets at easy access. They are located immediately after the main entrance in the hallway. The toilets all have paper towels but also have hand dryers except the disabled toilets which only have a hand dryer.



Sensory Friendly Days-

The sensory Friendly lunch and dinners will be held in the garden room with the door closed to block out external noises. There will be a different menu on offer to choose from, these will include large portioned “kids meals” example – Chicken nuggets, spaghetti, etc. All these meals will include access to the salad and veg bar. You are welcome to ask for your foods to be separated and will be served on a special plate to ensure no food is touching. Please ask staff if you have any other requests.
